

MADTool Installations

What you will need

MADTool may be installed on any Windows 98, NT or 2000 PC. MADTool also requires access to Microsoft MSDE or Microsoft SQL database.

Minimum system requirements:

- IBM-compatible PC with a Pentium processor
- Microsoft Windows 98, Windows NT 4.0, Windows 2000
- Windows compatible video card and monitor
- CD-ROM
- 20-60 MB of hard disk space, depending on the options you choose to install

Just before you install:

Before starting to install MADTool, be sure that all background applications are shut down. This includes any virus checking programs and all toolbars. Only Explorer and Systray need to be running, if shown at all.

To shut down background applications, press <Ctrl-Alt-Del> to see a list of applications running on your system (Windows NT/2000 users need to click on the Task List button). Repeat this process as necessary to shut down all background applications.

Installing MADTool

1. Insert the CD to launch AutoRun (or if AutoRun is disabled, on the Windows Run line type the letter of your CD drive followed by `:\madtool.exe`). The Wise Installation wizard will begin to load.
2. If the latest version of MDAC (Microsoft Data Access Components) is already installed on your PC, procedure to step 3. If the latest MDAC version is not installed, the MDAC installation dialog will now appear. Click OK to install these required files. Note that the MDAC installation system will automatically reboot your PC as part of the installation process.
3. You will now see the welcome to the MADTool install. Click **Next**
4. Click **I Agree** if you agree with the software license agreement.
5. If you would like to install MADTool in a folder other than the default select the browse button now. Click **Next**
6. If you would like to install an MSDE server on the computer make sure the *Install MSDE Server* option is checked. If you are accessing an MSDE server elsewhere on the network you do not need to install an MSDE server on this computer. Click **Next**
7. Click **Next** to select MADTool as the MADTool program manager group.
8. Click **Next** to select MADTool Icon group.
9. Click **Finish** to complete the MADTool installation.
10. Windows 98 users will be asked to reboot the server.
